The Mayor welcomed MTC Agent Mr A Davies Architects to the meeting.

Members were provided with Quote 40402E from Dawsons Stonemasonry for redecorating & repairs of the timber windows totalling: £10,044.00

Our Agent advised members of the itemised quote and members were shown images of the sunken back windows. The representative advised that these repairs only cover the

south and west elevation windows due to no scaffold being present elsewhere until the Town Hall works are completed.

Members discussed the quote and raised the following questions:

- Will the windows be watertight following the recommended repairs?
Yes and the works should provide an extra 5-10 years of life to the current windows.
- As they are, what is the current lifespan of the windows?
1-3 years max, the windowsills are almost completely past their life.
- Will there be more works as a follow up? Should there be a monetary contingency for works that aren't listed here?
a 40% recommendation should be sufficient for replacing and repairing timber especially the windowsills.
- Are the windows hard or softwood?
Unable to tell but the quality is excellent as far as timber is concerned. The metal windows in the offices are in excellent condition though.
- How many windows are there that may need repairs?
16 timber windows to the South and West elevation.
- For the deputy clerk, do we need to find additional quotes?
Not if Council agree not to. The current cost of the scaffold alone far exceeds the quote for replacing the windows by a multiple of at least 3, with the additional cost of procurement, a new company doing their own investigation and due diligence and then the Council time and meetings and the erection of new scaffold the costings would eclipse this quote.

Members thanked the representative for attending the meeting.

Cllr R Penhale-Thomas **proposed**, seconded by Cllr P Davies, that we accept the quote from the contractor with an additional contingency of 40% which can be utilised without calling another meeting.

RESOLVED: To accept quote 40402e at £10,044.00 with an additional 40% (£14,061.60) contingency for timber frame works and to instruct Dawsons Stonemasonry to proceed with the additional works.
